



WA Treasure Hunt Privacy Policy

At WA Treasure Hunt, we understand your privacy is important. Privacy information is as important to us, as it is to you. The information given to WA Treasure Hunt is treated with full respect, and for the purpose of the game process. This policy will outline our obligations, in managing information given to WA treasure Hunt.

WA Treasure Hunt has adopted the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) contained in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (the Privacy Act). The APPs govern the way in which we collect, use, disclose, store, secure and dispose of your Personal Information.

Information we collect

The information we collect is used for the primary purpose of conducting each game, and being able to provide you with the ability to participate in a manner set out in the guidelines. This information enables you to be identified as a participant of the game, and is collected by WA Treasure Hunt. If a third party is required to collect any additional information, you will be notified prior to doing so.

How information is collected

Information is collected when participants register to participate in the game. If there are unforeseen circumstances, which require WA Treasure Hunt to collect information outside the parameters of the game structure, you will be notified.

Information may also be collected by third parties in the spirit of the games, to further enhance the experience for participants. If this is to occur, you will be notified prior or during the game, and if required, after the game experience. This information sought would be used to increase the participant's experience, and for WA Treasure Hunt to improve game quality.

WA Treasure Hunt also utilises social networking services such as Instagram, Twitter and Facebook and to communicate with the public about the game. If communication is utilised through these services, we may collect your personal information, but we only use it to help us to communicate with you and or public. The social networking service will also handle your personal information for its own purposes. These services have their own privacy policies. You can access the privacy policies for Instagram, Twitter or Facebook on their relevant websites.

Security and Storage of your personal information

The storage of hard copy and digital personal information is secured and kept within WA. Only authorised personnel in addition to security clearances have access to any information stored within digital or hard copy vaults or platforms. When personal information is no longer required for the purpose it was obtained for, we will take all reasonable steps to permanently destroy and de-identify the personal information.

Disclosure of Personal Information

Circumstantial events may require WA Treasure to disclose your personal information. These events could be either,

- When required, directed or authorized by the law.
- Third parties, where you consent to the use or disclosure.
- For means of Emergency services being able to contact you

Third party collection

The structure of WA Treasure Hunt primarily requires the participant to engage with WA Treasure Hunt, to participate and engage in game activities. If any circumstances arise, and information is required to be sought from third parties, WA Treasure Hunt will take all reasonable steps to ensure you are made aware that any such information is being made available by the 3rd party.

Access to your personal information

WA Treasure Hunt will allow you access to any personal information you have given WA Treasure Hunt, for either updating or correcting it. In the event this is required, please contact us in writing. In order for WA Treasure Hunt to give you access to your information, and to protect your personal information, WA Treasure Hunt would require identification, to establish proof of identity.
